

The Norwegian National Advisory Unit on Trauma is thankful for the opportunity to comment on the guide line draft. The draft is simple and to the possible extent evidence based, as judged from the brief description below. I agree with the written recommendations.

The flow-chart is easy to follow. However, I am afraid that it has been simplified too much. It is not evident that caregivers with intermediate training should attempt SAD in cardiac arrest situations ONLY, and the flow-chart may be interpreted as to open for SAD on any patient.

Likewise, for the caregivers with advanced training, the use of endotracheal intubation does not contain any information on the use of drug-assisted intubation? (Which, to my knowledge, is correlated with a higher success-rate). Has the flow-chart been too simplified?
